We're anticipating a fun-filled day with food trucks, spot prizes and entertainment, while participants run/walk/skip/hop or jump around a course of 8 unique colour burst stations!

ABOUT KIDS IN NEED

Founded in 2014 by Linda and Graeme Roil, they set out to help foster carers by providing personalised care packs of essential items for children placed in foster care.

As foster carers themselves, they understood first hand, how many children arrived with little to no personal belongings and the Roils set about helping make their transition just a little bit easier.





The Kids in Need Waikato Charitable Trust was established in February 2018 and the organisation has grown to support children aged newborn to 17 years, who are being raised by someone other than their biological parents.

The caregivers we support are mainly Grandparents or wider whānau, many whom live in material hardship.

Today, we proudly assist 480 caregivers, who are raising 1200 children across the Waikato and Rotorua - our commitment to manaakitanga - kindness, respect and support- in our community.

Every child feels valued, and recognises the potential to create a better future.

Seasonal Care Packs

Each child receives a personalised summer and winter pack of essential items including clothing, underwear, socks, PJ's, shoes, toiletries, stationery, books, toys and something to cuddle. In 2023 we distributed **1595** care packs.





Christmas Gifts

Every child and their caregiver receive Christmas presents, generously donated by our caring community and distributed by Rotary Clubs across the region. In 2023 we gifted to **1142** children and **456** caregivers.

KINcare (Wellbeing Programmes)

We organise school holiday activity days at our Cambridge HQ for children and caregivers, host caregiver coffee groups in towns across the region and hold an annual "Big Day Out" at Finlay Park Adventure Camp for 100 participants.
